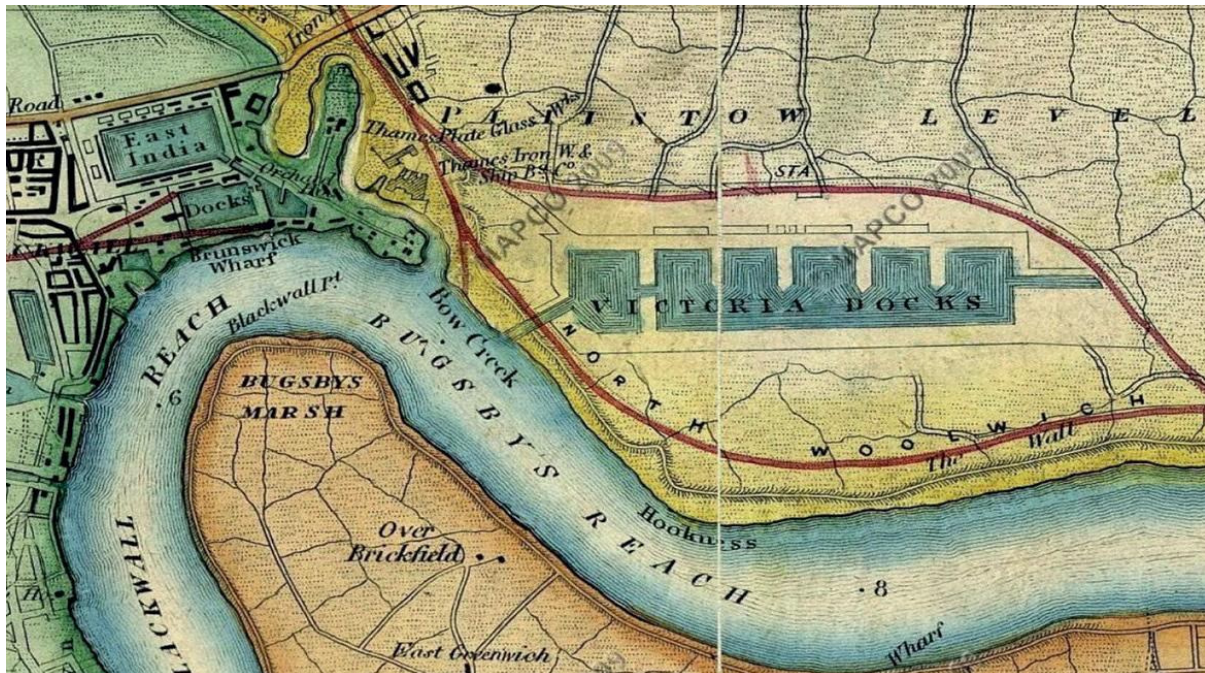

LANDS END RESTAURANT ON SUNBORN LONDON

In Sunborn London we value traditions and believe in importance of knowledge of the local heritage. Therefore we have named our restaurant Lands End - name given to Victoria Docks area by George Bidder in 1840's.

It was in the mid-1800s that the Victoria Docks came to life. In 1847 the well-known Victorian engineer George Bidder completed his railway from Stratford to North Woolwich. This new line was south of Canning Town followed the line of what is now Silvertown Way and North Woolwich Road, was called "Bidders Folly" because it passed through completely undeveloped marshland. George Bidder sensed the potential of the area and soon he had bought up the whole of the marshes between Bow Creek and Galleons Reach. He called the area "Lands End" and soon his investment was showing a handsome return as the land was sold for the docks and for a belt of factories along the River.

You may not know why we do it, but it's likely that the image of someone smashing a big bottle of champagne against a ship's hull - however counter intuitive - is one you've seen before. But why do we do it? Seafaring societies of old believed that breaking a bottle as your ship was launched or named afforded it luck for the many seafaring journeys that lay ahead. The US Navy's first steel battleship, the USS Maine, was the first to be launched with champagne specifically in 1890. Potentially used to prove the hardiness of the hulls, many historians believe the reason behind the choice of sparkling wine may simply be due to the power and elegance associated with champagne. Owners launch their vessels with bottles of the good stuff to this day. So, if you've got a superyacht sitting in a slipway somewhere, what bottle would be best to ceremoniously smash against it?
